BANYUWANGI, EAST JAVA

"JAVA FOREST PLANTATION MANAGED IN COLLABORATION WITH FOREST VILLAGE COMMUNITY"

1 - 2 December 2007

WHERE ? Banyuwangi

The location can be reached around 3 hours by car (convenience tourist bus) from Denpasar, the venue of the Conference to the Gilimanuk ferry harbor, across a beautiful Bali straits for about 1 hour then reach Banyuwangi region.



TO SEE WHAT ?

The northern part of Banyuwangi region covers mostly by the tropical monsoon forest of famous teak plantation of various ages, planted in inter-cropping with mainly corn, rice and grass for cattle feeding.

Toward the western part of Banyuwangi region the tropical forest is different, it is covered by a dense dark green needle leaves of *Agathis auriculiformis* (Damar) and *Pinus merkusii* plantation (Tusam) managed in hedge grow, inter-crops or agroforestry system with food crops such as aloe vera, corn, coffee, vanilli, nilam, zinger, papaya, chili, peanut, while gum rosin from pinus and kopal from dammar serve as main non woody forest products. Forest plantation, crops, cattle, forest village community and environment are harmonize in the ecosystem supported by strong culture and local wisdom.

Global change is far from this region, they are so beautiful and harmony, although the population density in Java island in very high (900 people/km²) with 26 millions people living in the villages sourrounding forest and with low skilled human resource (most of them are only elementary school graduates).

WEATHER

Temperature is ranged between 22° – 33°C, with Humidity 85%, Climate type C, rainfall between 1,000 – 1,500 mm/year, and rainy season from October to April. So please be ready with raincoat and shoes for walking.

FACILITY

You will be treated differently since you are our special guest.

ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICE PAYMENT ?

You'll regret if you miss it. The seat is very limited, only for 100 persons (5 medium buses). You will be charged only for hotel and accommodation US \$ 150,00 per person for traveling two days and one night.

WHEN ?

The visit is arranged on 1st – 2nd of December 2007, two days before the conference held.

Departure point will be in Hotel Ayodya where the buses are waiting to bring you to the experiences you'll never forget with Perhutani and hospitality of Banyuwangi people.
